### TRADITIONAL VS AUTHENTIC ASSESSMENT

O.N.L.I.N.E

Assessment is the process of finding out how well students have mastered the curriculum.

#### TRADITIONAL ASSESSMENT

-these types of tests (multiple choice, similar to standardized tests) are very low



O.N.L.I.N.E

-they emphasize memory over more complex skills with a focus on grades and ranking

-Based on psychometric theories of the 1950s

#### TRADITIONAL ASSESSMENT

-Individualshave developed specific and general abilities that can be measured by written tests and will predict /correlate in practice



O.N.L.I.N.E

- -the formats of these items tend to be very similar to each other
- -the conditions under which the tests are given are also standardized (for ex; amount of time, no talking.)
- -Produce results that are comparable between groups, (class to class) but it also tends to make testing highly artificial when compared to what scientists or anyone actually does in real life.

Uses activities that reveal what students can do ,emphasizing their strengths instead of their weaknesses.



O.N.L.I.N.E

Alternative assessment instruments are designed and structured differently and are graded and are scored differently

Since they are performance based, sometimes called performance assessments

Can be difficult to use when it comes to comparing a large group of students



O.N.L.I.N.E

-works well in learner centred classrooms since they are based on the idea that students can evaluate their own learning and learn from the evaluation process

-built around topics or issues of interests to the students

-replicate real world communication context and situations



O.N.L.I.N.E

-involve multi-stage tasks and real problems that require creative use of language rather than simple repetition

-require learners to produce a quality product or performance

-evaluation criteria and standardsare known to the students

-involve interaction between the assessor (instructor / peers/ self ) and the person being assessed



O.N.L.I.N.E

-allow for self-regulation, self-evaluation and self-correction

-methods include checklist ,portfolios,journals ...

#### TRADITIONAL ASSESSMENT

- -Generally relies on forced choice and written measures
- -relies on proxy measures of students learning to represent target skill
- -encourages memorization of correct answers
- -goal is to measure acquisition of knowledge
- -curriculum directs assessment
- -emphasis on developing a body of knowledge
- -promotes "what" knowledge
- -provides a one-time snapshot of student understanding
- -emphasizes competition
- -targets simplistic skills or tasks in a concrete ,singular fashion
- -priority on summative outcomes or product



O.N.L.I.N.E

#### **AUTHENTIC ASSESSMENT**

- -promotes integration of various written and performance measures
- -relies on direct measures of target skills
- -encourages divergent thinking in generating possible answers
- -goal is to enhance development of meaningful skills
- -assessment directs cirriculum
- -emphasis onensuring proficiency at real-world tasks
- -promotes "how" knowledge
- -provides an examination of learning over time
- -emphasises cooperation
- -prepares students for ambiguities and exceptions that are found in realistic problem settings
- -priority on the learning sequency or process
